Expert Testimony on Damages

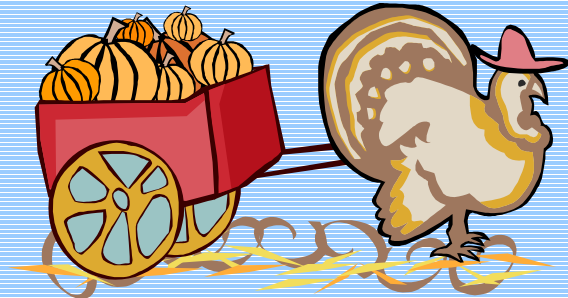
